**Parking Regulations and Guidelines for Student Drivers**

The following regulations should be observed by all motor vehicle operators while on King's Fork High School grounds.

1. Student drivers will be permitted to drive and park on school property.
2. Motorized vehicles parked on King's Fork High School grounds must be registered with the administrative office. Failure to register a vehicle for a parking decal will result in a student's loss of driving privileges. In addition, School Board Policy (7-04.4) states that "No student may bring any motor vehicle on school property unless prior to or immediately upon bringing a vehicle on school property the student shall obtain proper written authorization from the principal's office. If any student brings any motor vehicle on school property with or without proper authority he shall be deemed thereby to have consented to the search of the vehicle for alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons."
3. In order to register a vehicle, a student must present a valid Driver's License, a fee of \$85.00 for full school year or \$50.00 per semester, proof of insurance, DMV registration a signed Parking Regulations and Guidelines form and the Commonwealth of Virginia High School Student Parking Pass Application to the school's parking coordinator. Students driving to school should not arrive prior to 8:00 a.m. Upon arrival students should go immediately into the building. Students driving to school who are chronically tardy may receive disciplinary action or be subject to loss of their driving privilege.
4. From 8:25 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., students will not be allowed to go into the parking area without written authorization from the office, unless leaving for the day. Students leaving school without permission or without an approved early dismissal note from a parent may lose their driving privilege.
5. Decals should hang from the rearview mirror.
6. All drivers shall abide by traffic laws and regulations while operating a vehicle on school property. At no time should a vehicle exceed 10 mph.
7. All accidents of any kind should be reported to the Main Office immediately.
8. Vehicle operators are requested, for their own protection, to leave all valuables at home. All acts of vandalism or theft should be reported immediately to the office. **THE SCHOOL CAN NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ACTS OF VANDALISM OR THEFT IN THE SCHOOL'S PARKING LOTS.**
9. The city fire code prohibits parking in the fire lanes at school buildings.

**ANY STUDENT FOUND IN VIOLATION OF ANY OF THESE REGULATIONS SHALL FACE APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE SCHOOL'S ADMINISTRATION AND LOSE THE PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE TO SCHOOL WITHOUT REFUND OF THE PARKING REGISTRATION FEE.**

## HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING PASS APPLICATION

**Va. ## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

### Teen Driving Restrictions

Virginia's driving restrictions are not meant to penalize teen drivers, but to help them stay safe while they gain valuable driving experience. Studies have found that these restrictions work to reduce the number of car crashes among young drivers.

### Curfew Restrictions

If you are under age 18, Virginia law prohibits you from driving between midnight and 4 A.M. except when driving:

- to or from a place of business where you are employed;
- to or from an activity that is supervised by an adult and is sponsored by a school or by a civic, religious, or public organization;
- with a licensed spouse age 18 or older, parent or other adult acting in loco parentis who is occupying the front passenger seat,
- in case of an emergency, including responding to emergency calls as a volunteer firefighter or rescue squad personnel.

### Restrictions on the Number of Passengers

If you are under age 18, you may carry only one passenger under age 21, unless accompanied by a licensed parent, or other adult acting in place of a parent, in the front passenger seat. However, after you have held your license for one year, you may carry up to three passengers under age 21 in the following situations:

- Travel to and from a school-sponsored activity;
- A licensed driver 21 or older is in the front passenger seat; or
- In case of an emergency.

Learner's permit holders may not carry more than one passenger under age 18.  
(Passenger restrictions do not apply to family members)

### Cellular Telephone Restrictions

§ 46.2-818.2. Virginia's cellular telephone law prohibits any person from holding a handheld personal communications device while driving a moving motor vehicle on the highways in the Commonwealth.
