Section 5-4.4. Student conduct on school buses; riding privileges suspended; bus driver to maintain order. — A. The School Board requires that all students conduct themselves on the bus in a manner consistent with established standards for classroom student behavior in school and at school activities.

B. The school principal will have the authority to suspend the riding privileges of students and/or take other disciplinary actions for students who are constitute or cause disciplinary problems on the bus. Parents or guardians of children whose behavior or misconduct on school buses violates the Student Code Standards of Student Conduct or otherwise endangers the health, safety and welfare of riders shall be notified that their child/children face the loss of school bus riding privileges and/or other disciplinary actions. In such cases, the parents or guardians of the student will be responsible for arranging for the safe transportation of their children to and from school safely.

C. The bus driver shall be responsible for maintaining the orderly behavior of students on school buses and shall report misconduct to the student's principal by using the form provided by Suffolk Public Schools, with a copy being provided to the transportation office.
