- **Section 5-5.4. Food service records and reports; superintendent reports.** A. The superintendent is authorized to develop and implement an efficient and effective food services system for the students and employees of Suffolk Public Schools.
- B. The superintendent reports will periodically report to the School Board on the financial status of Suffolk Public School's food service operations. The superintendent also supervises the storage and distribution of all donated foods allocated by the U.S.D.A. for the school lunch program in such a manner as will ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
