

Section 9-3.2. Transfer from Persistently Dangerous School; Remain in Effect. —

A. Any student attending a school which has been designated as a persistently dangerous school by the Virginia Department of Education will be offered the opportunity to transfer to another school in the division which is not so designated. If there is not another school in the division to which students may transfer, other appropriate options may be explored.
~~the division may explore other appropriate options such as an agreement with a neighboring division to accept transfer students.~~

B. ~~In the event that~~ If a student elects to transfer, the transfer may be permanent or remain in effect as long as the student's original school is identified as persistently dangerous. (Adopted June 9, 2016; Ordinance Number 15/16-93; Effective Date: July 1, 2016)
