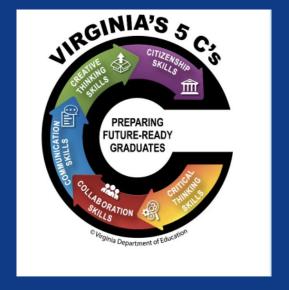

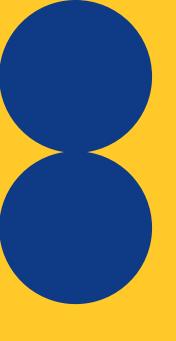

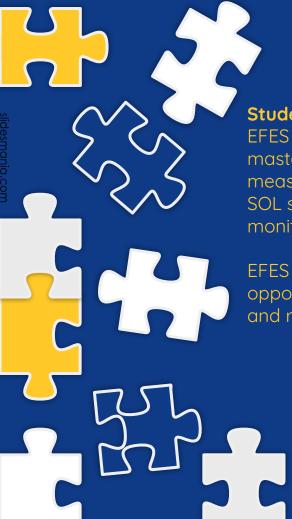
English

SMART Goal: By May 2026, EFES will reduce their failure rates by 10% by increasing the pass rate from 59% to 69% through the use of MasteryConnect assessments, UFLI assessments, VALLSS and Wonders Unit assessments to drive targeted remediation/intervention strategies, ensuring that all students receive the necessary support to meet or exceed academic standards.

Evidence-based Intervention:

Systematic, Explicit daily instruction, remediation and interventions that follows the Science of Reading and VLA, frequent progress monitoring, and following the district assessment model of teach, assess, reteach

Student Measures:

EFES will track the number of students who are performing mastery, near mastery, and remediation levels on MasteryConnect assessments. This measure will allow us to track and monitor students who are mastering each SOL standard and which students need remediation. EFES will track and monitor students who are High Risk, Moderate Risk and Low Risk on VALLSS.

EFES will measure which students attend the offered remediation/intervention opportunities and their effect on the students' learning through remediation and reassessment.





English

Staff Measures:

EFES staff will complete PLCs weekly, and will use the district provided progress monitoring data sheet to have data analysis discussions. This will allow EFES to monitor which students need remediation, before school tutoring, WIN Time, Saturday Academy and other interventions offered at EFES. This will be measured through the PLC administrator checklist and other walkthrough measures.

EFES administrators and leadership team will monitor the use of highly qualified instructional materials and explicit, systematic instruction measured by weekly walkthroughs and coaching cycles.

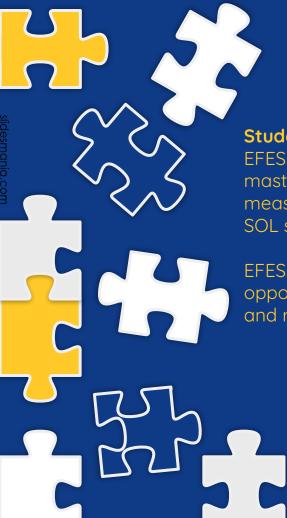
SMART Goal:

By May 2026, EFES will increase the percentage of students demonstrating proficiency on core academic standards from 57% to 67%, as measured by MasteryConnect benchmark assessments and SOLs, through schoolwide implementation of Universal Backwards Design as our instructional planning strategy.

Evidence-based Intervention:

All teachers will utlize Universal Backwards Design when planning rigorous, aligned instruction.





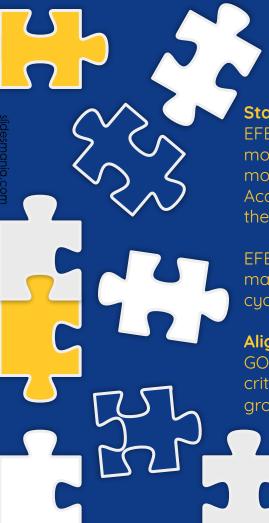

EFES will measure which students attend the offered remediation/intervention opportunities and their effect on the students' learning through remediation and reassessment.

EFES Staff will complete PLCs weekly, and will use the district provided progress monitoring data sheet to have data analysis discussions. This will allow EFES to monitor which students need remediation, before school tutoring, Saturday Academy and other interventions offered at EFES. This will be measured through the PLC administrator checklist and other walkthrough measures.

EFES administrators and leadership team will monitor the use of rigorous, aligned materials planned during PLCs measured by weekly walkthroughs and coaching cycles.

Science

SMART Goal:

By May 2026, science achievement for all students will increase pass rate from 51% to 65% (increase 14%) on the SOL assessment through the implementation of the 5E instructional model and inquiry-based learning strategies to deepen student understanding and engagement in science concepts.

Evidence-based Intervention:

All teachers will use the 5E model to facilitate inquiry based science instruction and hands on experiences.





Student Measures:

EFES will track student data through MasteryConnect assessments including the pre, mid and post test. EFES will also monitor teacher created summative and formative assessments.

EFES will measure which students attend the offered remediation/intervention opportunities and their effect on the students learning through remediation and reassessment (WIN Time).





Staff Measures:

EFES will monitor and track implementation of all science lesson plans by ensuring that the district provided lesson plans and the 5e learning model is included in lesson plans and carried out in the classroom

EFES Staff will complete PLCs weekly, and will use the district provided progress monitoring data sheet to have data analysis discussions. This will allow EFES to monitor which students need remediation, before school tutoring and other interventions offered at EFES. This will be measured through the PLC adminstrator checklist and other walkthrough measures.

Social Studies

SMART Goal:

Teachers will incorporate district provided instructional best practice routines into daily instruction.

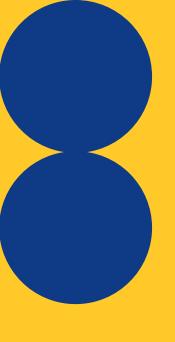

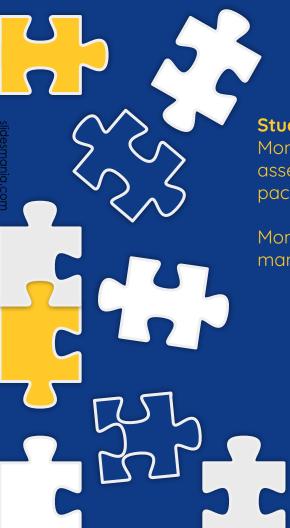
SMART Goal:

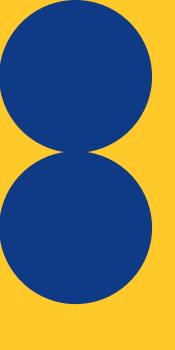

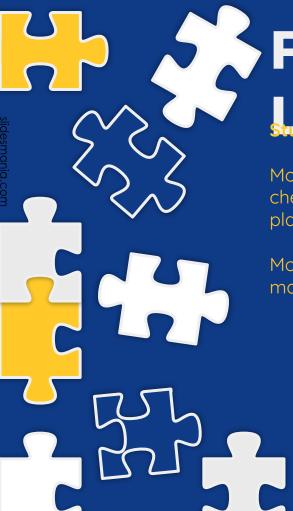

Job-Embedded Professional Learning with Coaching & Resource Accessibility



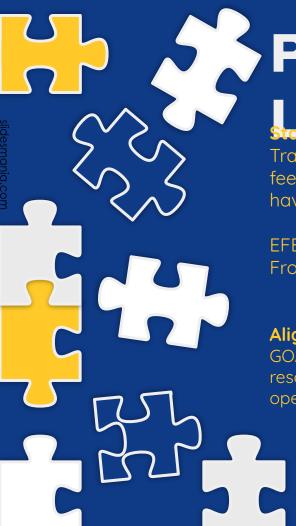

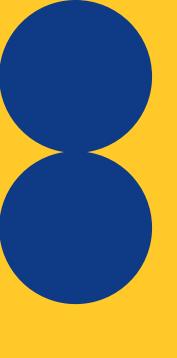

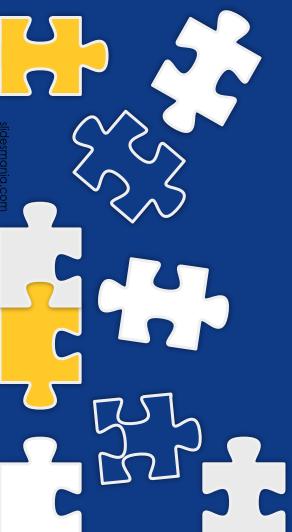
By June 2026, the total number of office discipline referrals will
