Terms of Agreement

- A. The initial term of this agreement shall begin on the day of award and continue through June 30, 2021 after which this agreement may be extended for four (4) additional one year periods, beginning July 1st and ending June 30th of each year, unless otherwise terminated by either party by giving written notice by May 1st of any given year. The School Board may approve a price increase for each subsequent year. The request shall be presented in writing by April 1st of each year and the cost increases shall not exceed the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as developed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U. S. Department of Labor, for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) south, for the preceding calendar year.
- 1. It is mutually agreed that Phase I price will be \$259,907.08 to complete the work described in the RFP submission and any subsequent clarifications.
- 2. It is further agreed that Bazon-Cox Associates will provide John Littlefield, project manager, weekly updates including, but not limited to, staffing for the proposed project, completion percentage, and a one-week look ahead.
- 3. It is agreed that Bazon-Cox and Associates will adequately staff the work described in the RFP and agree to the March 30, 2020 deadline. Extensions may only be granted if the delays are a result of force majeure.
