Terms of Agreement

The initial term of this agreement shall begin on July 1, 2020 and continue through June 30, 2021 after which, this agreement may be automatically extended for four additional one year periods, beginning July 1st and ending June 30th of each year, unless otherwise terminated by either party by giving written notice March 31st of each year. Price for the initial term of this agreement shall be negotiated as a part of this solicitation. The School Board may approve a price increase for each subsequent year but the cost increases shall not exceed the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as developed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U. S. Department of Labor, for all Urban Consumers (CPIU) South, for the preceding calendar year. The School Board reserves the right to extend this contract for additional time during the re-solicitation process should it be in the best interest of the School Board.

Pricing details:

\$31,235 for the first year of the contract for claims handling fees including administration.

Projects would be billed either at a negotiated hourly rate or by project.
