

Ordinance 2025/26-27

Section 8-42.2. Declaration of Policy; requirements for home instruction. — A. The School Board recognizes that when the requirements of Virginia Code §22.1-254.1 (1950), as amended, are complied with, instruction of children by their parents is an acceptable form of education under the policy of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

B. Any parent of any child who ~~will have reached the fifth birthday~~ is five years or older on or before September 30 of any school year and ~~which child is not yet eighteen years old who has not passed the eighteenth birthday~~ may elect to provide home instruction in lieu of school attendance if ~~he~~ the parent:

- (i) holds ~~a high school diploma; baccalaureate degree in any subject from an accredited institution of higher education;~~ or
- (ii) is a teacher of qualifications prescribed by the Board of Education; or
- ~~(iii) has enrolled the child or children in a correspondence course approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction; or~~
- ~~(iv)(iii)~~ provides a program of study or curriculum which may be delivered through a correspondence course or distance learning program or in any other manner; or
~~in the judgment of the division superintendent, includes the standards of learning objectives adopted by the Board of Education for language arts and mathematics and~~
- (iv) provides evidence that the parent is able to provide adequate education for the child.
