WHO CAN ATTEND THE PROM?

- Juniors or Seniors in "good standing" are eligible to attend the prom:
- Freshmen or Sophomores are allowed at Prom, if **ONLY** invited by a Junior or Senior.
- Good standing means that you/your guest have good behavior at school and in the community.
- A student is not eligible to attend if he or she has excessive disciplinary infractions.
- In order to purchase a ticket, all debts Chromebook fees, Textbook fees, Club fees, Sports fees (uniforms), and Class Dues (each year) must be paid.
 - Freshman Dues \$10; Sophomore Dues \$15
 - Junior Dues \$30; Senior Dues \$50
- ONLY 11th and 12th grade students can purchase tickets.
- Each Junior or Senior may invite one eligible guest. LHS administration will approve all prom attendees.

TICKET INFORMATION

- Prom tickets are \$60.00 all tickets will be purchased online starting Thursday, February
 9th.
- ALL tickets MUST be purchased by April 21, 2023.

You will receive an online receipt for your payment. Be sure to hold on to this receipt because it will be required in order to pick up your tickets on May 1-May 5, 2023

On Monday May 1-May 5, 2023 tickets will be distributed:

- You MUST have your receipt to pick up your tickets.
- You must be in attendance that day in order to receive your tickets.
- No other students, friends, or family members can pick up your tickets.

You MUST have your ticket(s) Saturday, May 6, 2023. NO TICKET, NO PROM - NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Because all prom-related expenses are paid well in advance of the prom, there will be **NO REFUNDS** on prom tickets and absolutely **NO TRANSFERS** from one person to another.



GUEST POLICY

Each Junior or Senior may invite one eligible guest. LHS administration will approve all prom attendees.

Guests must be of high school age (Juniors & Seniors ONLY) or no older than the age of 19 (unless approved by administration) and in good standing at his/her school and in the community.

- ✓ You are **REQUIRED** to fill out a *Guest Request form prior to purchasing your tickets for prom.*
- ✓ Guests may NOT be OLDER THAN 19

Photocopy of a picture ID must be provided with your guest request form.

✓ All Lakeland High School students invited as guests must ALSO fulfill the debt and requirements in the "Who Can Attend Prom" section.

You must request a guest card during ticket sales and it **MUST** be approved BEFORE you purchase a ticket for your guest.

- ✓ You must fill out the card and return it
- ✓ NO GUEST CARD, NO GUEST
- ✓ Guest requests MUST be in by March 24, 2023. Guest denials will be announced on April 7, 2023
- ✓ You will be notified by administration of whether or not your quest is approved:
 - There will be background checks conducted on ALL guests that are not LHS students.
 - If your guest is not approved, there will be **NO TICKET REFUNDS**; which is why you cannot purchase your guest ticket until they are approved.
 - Therefore, be sure that your guest is aware of the guidelines, policies, rules and regulations.

THE NIGHT OF THE PROM

Before heading to the Prom on May 6, 2023, do not forget your picture ID (non LHS students) and prom ticket(s):

- Each person attending the prom MUST show a PHOTO ID to security before entering Hub757.
- You and your guest must have ticket(s) in order to get into the prom.
- PARENTS OR GUARDIANS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE HUB757.
- There will be NO Loitering in the parking lot; police officers and JROTC members will be monitoring throughout the night.
- REMEMBER: NO TICKET, NO PROM AND NO EXCEPTIONS

In addition:

- When you leave the prom for ANY reason, there will be NO RE-ENTRY.
- Don't forget to bring your keys, camera, cell phones, evening bags, etc. with you when you come in.
- Lakeland High School Code of Conduct will be in full force the night of Prom.
- Students who appear to be under the influence of any substance will be searched, turned over to law enforcement, and parents will be notified.
- There **WILL NOT** be a hat/coat check.
- There will be a photographer at the prom. A price list will be provided at a later date.

A Senior King and Queen will be voted on at prom. (Only LHS Seniors Vote)
A Junior Prince and Princess will be voted on at prom (Only LHS Juniors Vote)
